

SC05 Latin language and culture for beginners

This course will run subject to sufficient numbers enrolling – there will be a limited number of places available

This course offers a comprehensive appraisal of the language of ancient Rome. It also explores some central features of Latin literature. In this course we aim to examine the cultural context surrounding classical Latin and its successors. In the first term, those who have knowledge of Latin grammar will be able to review it at a leisurely pace, while people with little or no knowledge will have an opportunity to learn the basics of the Latin grammar. There will be time to explore some favourite topics more in-depth through inclusive but leisurely class discussion. *Wheelock's Latin* 7th edition, by Frederic M. Wheelock and Richard A. Lafleur.
